

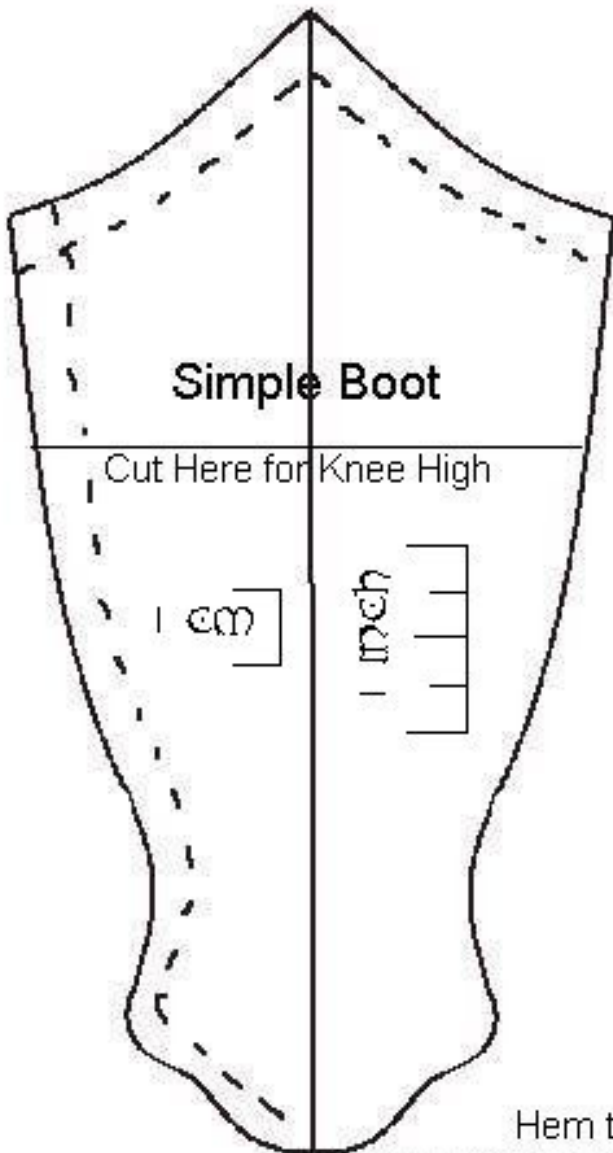
Boots!

Lots and lots of boots even!

From super simple to completely insane...

Everything was scanned at 72 dpi – I've put 'rulers' on all the patterns, hopefully that helps some.

Pay attention to which doll the pattern was made FOR though – the basic SHAPE will work for any (high heeled!) doll, but the individual pieces may need to be futzed about with.



Hem top edge

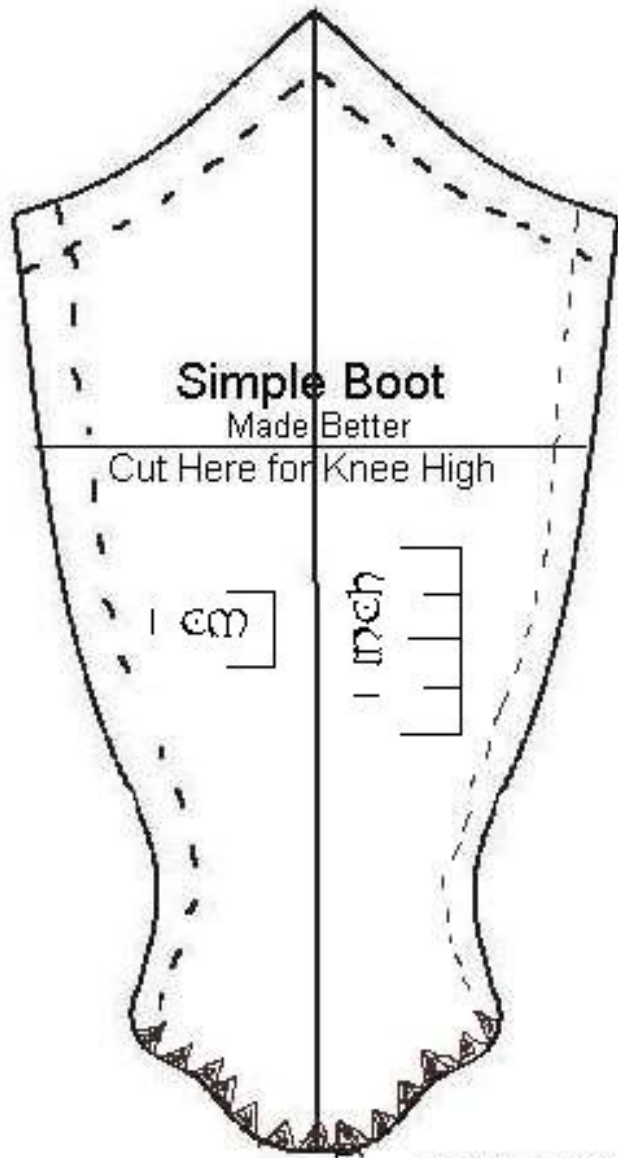
Fold boot in half, right sides together

Sew 1/4" seam along edges

Trim VERY close at toe, clip heel, press or glue down seam allowance

Turn right side out.

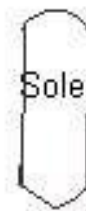
Simple Boot

Made Better

Cut Here for Knee High

1 cm

1 inch



Sole

Cut four of light cardboard
 Cut two of leather
 Rubber band one cardboard to each foot
 Form upper around it
 Glue second of cardboard to each foot
 Glue leather to each foot

Hem Top Edge

With right sides together sew

1/4" center back seam to heel

Turn right side out, place on doll

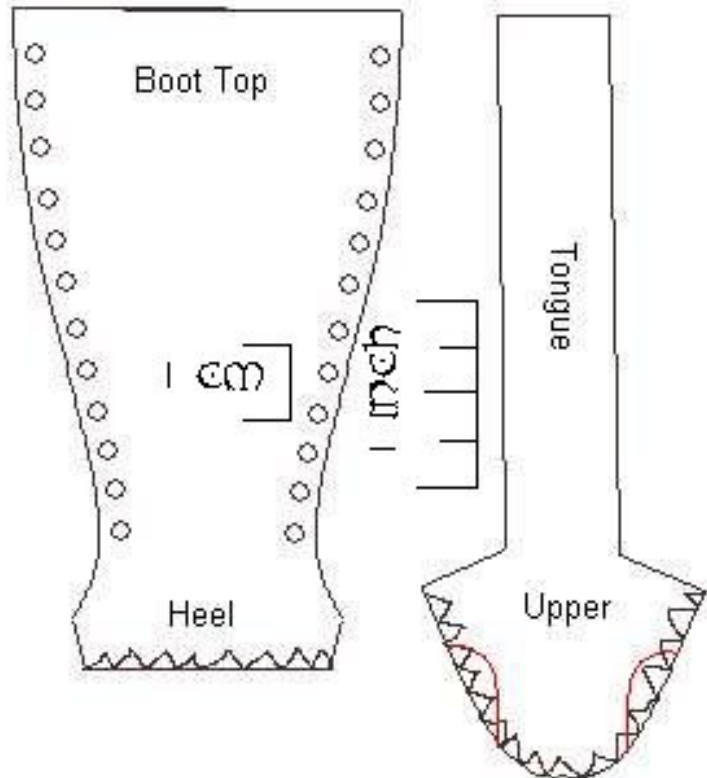
Fold points over cardboard sole and glue down

Finish with leather sole

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Basic Laced Boot

There are *no* seam allowances on this one
If you're making it out of anything but leather, you'll need to add them



Made for a flat foot,
but works for high heeled feet
just cut out the red curves on the upper

Place the upper on the barbie leg lining tongue up center front
rubber band around the ankle to hold it in place

Stretch the points down over toes and sides and glue over cardboard sole

Attache eyelets to boot top

Place the boot top around the ankle with eyelets lining up the center front
and bottom side pieces overlapping upper on foot

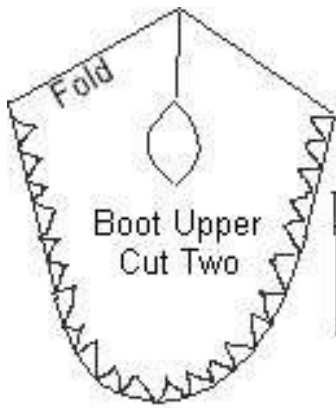
Rubber band in place around ankle

Stretch points down and glue around cardboard sole

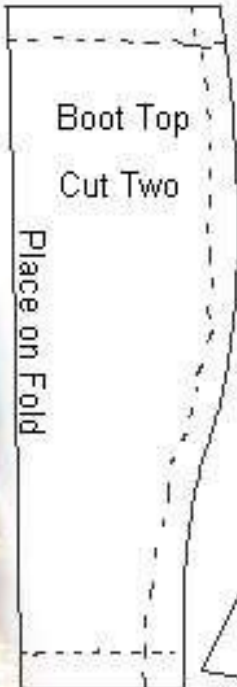
Glue remaining soles on, cut all rubber bands,

remove boot (after the glue is dry! *grin*) and lace.

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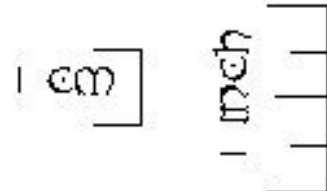
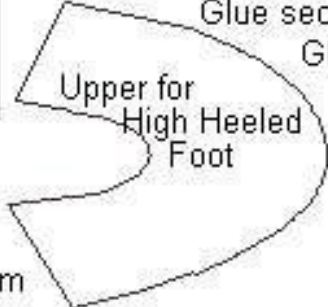
Glue or hem fold down
Place around barbie foot - Glue flat edges at heel
Glue points down around soul to form upper



Hem top and bottom
Sew center back seam with right sides together
Turn

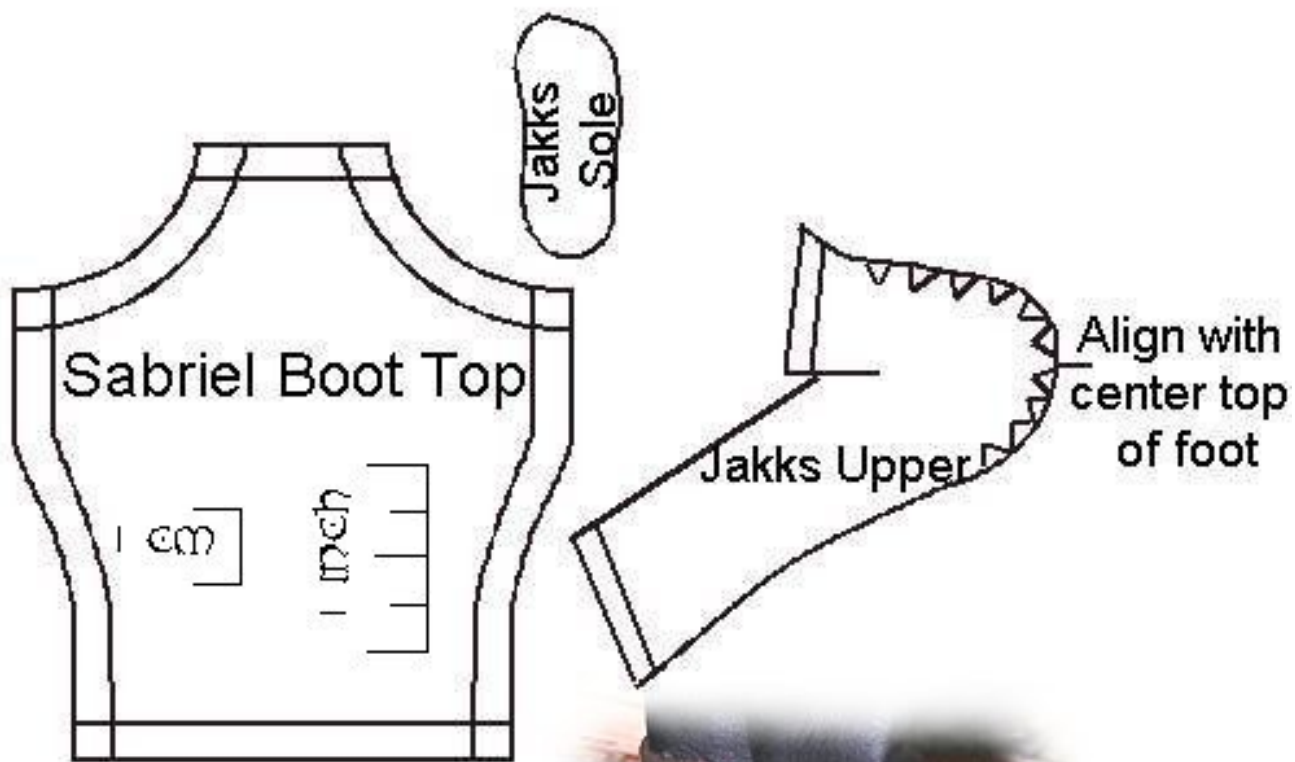


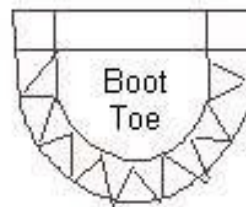
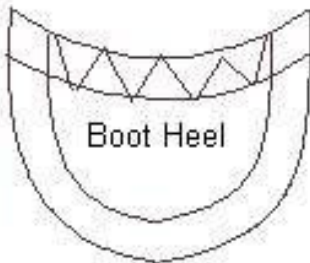
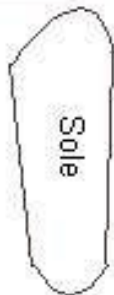
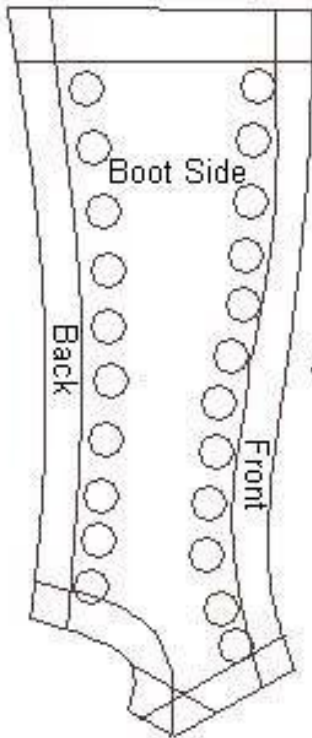
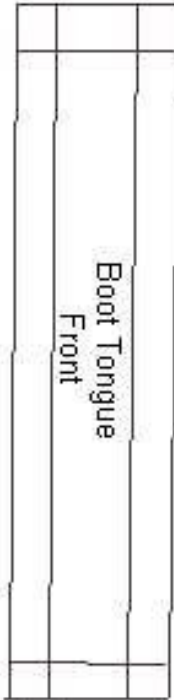
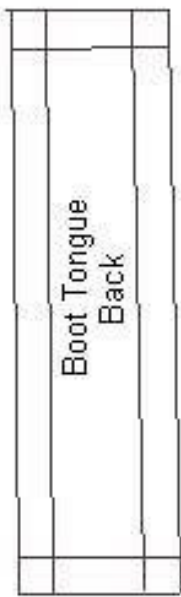
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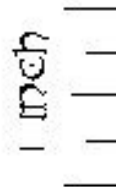
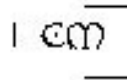
For Cuff extend boot top up about 1/2", do *not* hem or seam extra length





Alrighty - this one actually has seam allowances everywhere -
 if you're working in thicker leather remember to remove them.
 The tongues attach at the heel and toe seam lines
 (ie. where they attach to the boot sides)

This boot was originally made for a Darci doll
 It will probably fit a Jakks with no problem,
 Babs will need to have the toes stuffed and a smaller heel.



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My own little shoe 'lasts'

Magic sculp added to a pair of whacked off barbie legs
I left her heel alone, just gave her a 'real' set of toes/ball of the foot
Boots/shoes made on these lasts fit plain barbie feet fine
but the toes need to be stuffed with about a q-tip worth of cotton

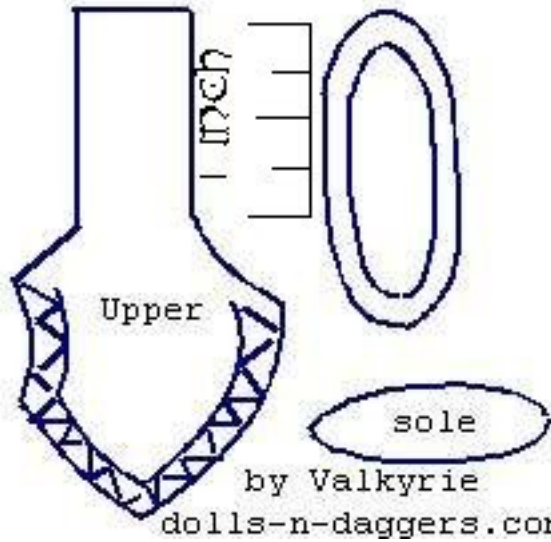
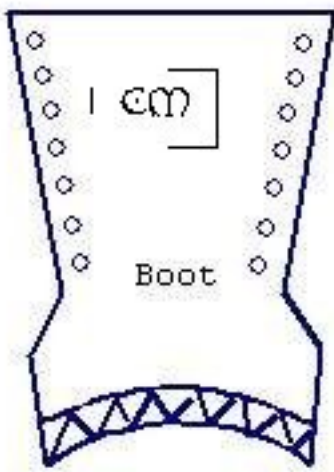


Pretty cool huh?
